

### **Filling Elected Official Vacancies in Arizona**



## County & State Elected Officials with 4-Year Terms\*

#### 2-years or less remaining in term or next primary election is within 90 days

GOVERNOR (STATE) OR BOARD OF SUPERVISORS (COUNTY) APPOINTS

Must be of the same political party as the individual vacating the seat.

Appointee serves until the next general election is held and the successful candidate takes the oath of office.

\*Excluding the governor, who if resigns is succeeded by the secretary of state.

# More than 2-years remaining in term and next primary election is in more than 90 days


GOVERNOR (STATE) OR BOARD OF SUPERVISORS (COUNTY) APPOINTS AND STANDARD PRIMARY & GENERAL ELECTIONS ARE HELD

The successful candidate may take office anytime within 90 days of the election and serves the remainder of the term.

### **State Legislature**

LD<sup>\*</sup> represented by an individual from an organized political party and more than 30 PCs<sup>\*\*</sup> in the LD and county PARTY NOMINATES, BOARD OF SUPERVISORS APPOINTS Vacancy occurs



LD<sup>\*</sup> not represented by an individual from an organized political party or less than 30 PCs<sup>\*\*</sup> in the LD and county

#### CITIZEN PANEL NOMINATES, BOARD OF SUPERVISORS APPOINTS



^^Individuals that meet the requirements to serve in the legislature, reside in the same district and county, and belong to the same political party as the individual that vacated the seat.
