Distribution Flow

- /1. \$625,600 for The Registration Compliance Program.
- /2. \$1.0 million for economic strength highway projects recommended by the Commerce Authority and approved by the State Transportation Board.
- /3. HURF Transfer to DPS of \$119,961,000.
- /4. County Share of HURF Revenue to be allocated to each county based on the Fuel Factor and Unincorporated Population.

Gas Tax (18¢ per gal) MVD Econ. (Reg. Str. Enforce.) Fund \$0.63 /1 \$1.0/2

- /5. Monies are allocated to individual cities and towns based 50% proportional share of incorporated population and 50% on the county of origin proportional share of incorporated population.
- /6. Cities over 300 thousand persons receive an additional 3% of the state share of HURF.
- /7. Transfer 1.51% of SHF share of VLT to the Parity Compensation Fund. Laws 2005, Ch. 306.
- /8. Special Transfer of SHF share of VLT to the General Fund. Laws 2010, 7th Sp. Sess. Ch.12 & Laws 2011, Ch. 28.
- /9. Distribution of SHF monies for design, acquisition and construction of controlled access highways.
- /10. Statutory payments to third parties from VLT collected by third parties
- /11. \$86,255,600 for the MVD operating budget is shifted from HURF back to SHF for FY13.
- /12. Transfer from SHF to DPS. Part of these monies will be used for Vehicle Replacement.
